

The Department of Congenital Heart Disease and Paediatric Cardiology at the University Hospital Schleswig-Holstein, Campus Kiel offers self-funded cardiovascular magnetic resonance (CMR) fellowships. The fellowship will encompass both, research and clinical training in paediatric and adult congenital heart disease (ACHD) CMR imaging.

Clinical trainees in paediatric cardiology, cardiology and radiology are eligible.

A minimum of 6 months stay is required. The fellowship will include participation in clinical CMR service with theoretical (lectures, reviewing of CMR sessions, reporting of CMR sessions under supervision) and practical training (hands-on training at the scanner). The training programme is supervised by Inga Voges who has CMR level 3 and CMR in Congenital and Paediatric Heart Disease level 3 competency (EACVI).
